

Briefs from Brent

In Philippians 3:20 Paul reminds us that "our citizenship is in heaven". From a missional standpoint this reminds me that no matter which country I am a citizen of on earth, or how proud I am of that country, my focus should not be nationalistic. I have had the opportunity to travel in 9 nations besides my own. I enjoyed all of those experiences but I was always glad to get home. I am a proud citizen of the United States. I was born here, raised here, and have always been proud to claim my citizenship in the USA. I would rather live here than anywhere else on earth.

But I am not going to live here forever. That is true on one level because physically no one lives forever. Seventy, eighty, or ninety years and most of us are done for. Our bodies give out and we stop breathing and we are no more. But spiritually, life continues. For the believer in Christ life will continue in the place called heaven. But notice that Paul does not say that we as believers in Christ will one day have citizenship in heaven but that our citizenship is in heaven now. I was fortunate enough to become a citizen of the USA simply because of the citizenship of my parents and the place of my birth. I became a citizen of heaven through a process of rebirth when by faith I received Christ's offer of forgiveness. My citizenship is not by merit or from my efforts, rather it is a free gift of God, offered by God's grace and transacted in mercy. I don't have citizenship in heaven because I am a good person. I have heavenly citizenship because I have a Savior who loves me. While I am traveling the highways of this earth and visiting the places of this earth, I am awaiting this Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ. The earthly body that I move around in now, with all of its frailties, shortcomings, and deformities will one day be transformed into a new body fit for the portals of heaven. The body I live in now is a lowly vessel made with clay and shaped by the potter's wheel of humanity. But the body I receive in heaven will not be a mass marbled by human DNA, but will be designed to reflect the glorious body of the Lord Jesus Christ. In heaven I will have a body that is filled with the righteousness of Christ, thus fit for the presence of Christ and able to live and thrive for all eternity.


